Individual Professionals Members

An Individual Professional member of FPRA in good standing may transfer their membership from any chapter of the Association to any other chapter of the Association within the membership year. The Association will charge no additional membership dues or processing fees. Home chapter assignments are based on where a member works and/or lives. The transferring member must pay dues to the Association as a member of the new chapter at the start of the new membership year. No processing fees are incurred as long as membership is kept current.

Institutional Professional Members

These memberships are paid for and held by the institution. If an Institutional Professional member leaves the institution that paid the member’s dues the membership remains with the institution. The vacated Institutional Professional Membership will remain in force until Oct. 31. Any new person taking over the new membership must complete and submit a membership application along with a one-time processing, as long as membership is kept current, fee of \$35. Note: The departing FPRA member must re-apply as an individual Professional or Institutional Professional Member (with new employer).
